Hi,

We hope that you are well and keeping safe.

We are very aware that some people experience difficulties when routed to PayPal to make the payment. There are a number of reasons that problems occur, but we hope that help provided below will enable you to complete the process...

### 1. **Paypal**

If you have a Paypal account then you can simply log in at [www.paypal.co.uk](http://www.paypal.co.uk) and once in your account, select "Send"

This will take you to a page where under "Send Money" you can enter our email address  
Our Email address is [chiefsscpayments@gmail.com](mailto:chiefsscpayments@gmail.com)

If you do not enter this email address exactly as shown above, then Paypal will not find our account.

If everything is correct then click "NEXT" and you will then be asked to enter the amount....

Press 6 0 0

Check that you are paying £6 and if happy then click on "Continue" to confirm and complete the payment.

### 2. **Pay By BACS**

If you prefer to pay us from your on-line bank account then please do so.

You will need our Account number and sort code.

### 3. **Cash or Cheque**

If you prefer you can of course send payment to our treasurer by post:

Make cheques payable to "Chiefs Supporters Club"

Remember, we already have your name address and email address from the form that you submitted, so once we receive payment, we will post your membership card to you. (Please allow up to 10 working days).

Also, once you have paid then you are eligible to register as a member on the web site to gain access to the "members only" pages (special discounts, newsletter etc). Please allow a couple of days after payment before registering to give us time to record your membership on our records.

Please do not confuse JOINING and REGISTERING on the web site.

**Join** – sends us your details and requires an annual payment.

**Registering** – (Sign Up) This is where you choose a password for your web account and sends a request to us to authorise your access to our “members only” pages. Once authorised (Allow a few days) you will receive a confirmation email so you can “log in” on the web site for full access.

Membership and Web site full access is for the whole season. Renewing your membership on time retains permissions.
